Background:

The modern constructor has to manage more than just the construction itself. The process:

As an organisation, the steps involved for you are:

1. Applying for certification:

Review and accept our customised Proposal, and you're underway!

2. Achieving certification:

An on-site certification audit (at your premises) will be conducted, where we will examine the extent to which you address the program criteria. Areas of concern will be reported. Once we are satisfied there are no outstanding issues that present an unacceptable risk, we will issue a *Certificate of Confidence*. For accredited certifications, we will also advise CCF of your attainment of certification.

3. Maintaining certification:

Depending on the level of risk, we will conduct annual re-certification audits (and in some cases special and follow-up audits) to examine the extent to which you continue to address the program criteria. Areas of concern will be reported. So long as we continue to be satisfied there are no outstanding issues that present an unacceptable risk, a *Certificate of Confidence* will be re-issued annually. Similarly, for accredited certifications, we will advise CCF of your maintenance of certification.
